The benefit to UVI is to provide a skilled workforce, which adds value to the community and its employers.

UVI's academic programs require its students take career guidance courses, which the course title varies from a program. UVI utilizes numerous online tools and counseling activity based on build career strategies to secure employment after graduation, as well as approaches from the beginning of the program:

1. Elaborate and upload resumes and cover letters.
2. Review interview tactics.
3. Encourage student to become in volunteers give a student much needed experience, the chance to explore potential fields of interest.
4. Offer opportunities to network with professionals with the community and using online resources.
5. Encourage and trains students to leverage their externships to make the most out of employment potentiality.
6. Academic curriculum is designed to train students in leveraging opportunities, practicing innovation, creating economic and social value, and taking risks.
7. Promote and schedule student events, such as workshops, career activities, and other tools that will help fortify students' professional skills.
